Note: Office space will be made available for the award recipient at the offices of the donor up to the equivalent of a day per week for up to a year, providing the recipient with the opportunity to gain experience by participating in a project of the donor. Should the recipient choose to participate in the project of the donor, the recipient would be expected to follow the code of ethics of the donor.
