



Preamble

Process

- Student registers with [Accessibility Services](#);
- Disability advisor reviews the medical documentation and assesses with the student if additional extension(s) may be required to complete the graduate degree;
- If extension(s) are recommended by the disability advisor, the student is required to complete a work plan and obtain relevant signatures for approval (section 2 below).

Note: A student requesting disability-related extension(s) must be in good standing and making satisfactory progress toward degree requirements. Annual supervisory committee reports may be requested by the School of Graduate Studies.
